ACCOMMODATION



Cabin insulated for 4 people, including: 2 bedrooms, each with 2 single beds (39"), fitted sheets and pillows with pillowcases; a fully equipped kitchen with pans, pots, dishes, utensils, dish soap and sponges; a counter and storage; a table with 4 chairs; a propane stove; a toilet cabinet; electric heating and a wood stove (wood included).

All cabins have electricity (15-amp / 120-volt outlets) and running potable water inside. Showers are located in the sanitary block, near the community room.

Outside the cabin: a porch, a picnic table, a refrigerator and a freezer (18 cu ft).



On-ice cabin insulated for 4 people, including: 2 wooden bunk beds and a futon (can accommodate a child), fitted sheets and pillows with pillowcases; a full bathroom with incinerating dry toilet, sink, and shower; a fully equipped kitchen with coffee maker, kettle, toaster, utensils, 2 propane burners, dishes (8 settings), pans and pots, dish soap; a rectangular table with 4 chairs; a solar refrigerator and freezer (6 cu ft).

All cabins have electricity (15-amp / 120-volt outlets) and non-potable running water inside.

The Mwak^w cabins were created in a spirit of energy autonomy and a minimal ecological footprint. They require greater participation on the part of their users. A memory aid will help you make this rental more responsible. Thank you for your collaboration!

Check-in at the Waconichi reception Hours from 7 AM to 9 PM Reservations must be made by phone



LOCALISATION

30 km northeast of Chibougamau via Route 167 and 81 km south of Mistissini. At km 252 of route 167 N, take the Route du Nord. At km 4, turn right and continue for 8 km to the Waconichi Lake site. Be careful, unpaved path for 12 km.



DEPARTURE

BEFORE 11 A.M.


Cleanliness: Please leave the property as you found it, clean and in good condition. Otherwise, a \$100 housekeeping fee will be charged to you. In case of breakage or a problem, do not hesitate to bring it to the attention of the manager of the Waconichi cabins site.

Important: The fishing season has ended, so fishing onsite will not be possible.

It is not possible to get to your lodging by vehicle. A network of sidewalks and paths connects all buildings. Equipment is provided for the transportation of your luggage.

Access to the on-ice cabins is possible:

- By snowshoe path
- By snowmobile shuttle service from Waconichi reception







Water is potable on the site, except in on-ice cabins.



Dogs are prohibited in all buildings of the wildlife sanctuary, except for duly identified guide and assistance dogs. Other domestic animals are prohibited at all times.



Smoking is strictly prohibited in all buildings, including accommodation areas and rental units.



Due to the remote location of the Waconichi cabins site, the entire area is not covered by cellular networks. These communication limitations, combined with the site's distance from hospitals and emergency services, can result in significant delays when emergency interventions are required.



Snowmobile traffic is strictly prohibited on roads and trails that are unmarked, unsigned, or undeveloped. In accordance with the *Loi sur la conservation et la mise en valeur de la faune*, the use of off-road vehicles in a wildlife sanctuary is permitted only in designated areas.

QUIET AND RESPECT

Thank you for respecting the tranquility and the space of other groups present on the site. Any group causing a disturbance on site will receive a warning. If this first warning is not heeded, the site manager may evict that group without refund. Thank you also for respecting the work of employees and the site's operating hours (7 a.m. to 9 p.m.).

Located near the Waconichi cabin reception, this room can accommodate up to 50 people for meetings, gatherings, or other social activities.

Equipment and amenities:


- Comfort and technology: propane heating, television, projector, and wireless internet connection.

SENTIER DE LA POINTE - POINTE TRAIL







Walking path	Pointe trail
Description	Set off on an adventure along a 5 km loop near the Waconichi cabins. Walk through black spruce forests and cross a bog with western arborvitae trees. Enjoy breathtaking panoramic views for a hike full of discoveries!
Difficulty level	Intermediate
Elevation gain	35 m
Length	5 km - loop (with a 3 km shortcut option)
Starting points	Several options: Behind cabin 1 Behind cabin 11 At the gazebo parking lot Near the on-ice cabins
