WACONICHI LAKE CABINS INFORMATION GUIDE

ABOUT THE WACONICHI LAKE CABINS

Reception: Check in at the Waconichi welcoming office

Fall schedule from 8am to 8pm

Location: 30 km from Chibougamau - Turn right at KM4 on the route du Nord (route 10), follow the signs

for 8 km (about 12 km on gravel road).

Facilities: 11 cabins with a capacity of 4 persons

2 floating cabins with a capacity of 4 persons

Services available on site:

Waconichi reception - 8am to 8pm, 7 days a week

<u>Fishing season closed – fishing is prohibited after Labor Day in the Wildlife Reserve</u>

Central sanitary block with showers

Launching ramp for personal watercraft: not on site!

- KM 255 of route 167, 3 km from Rupert welcoming office

Marina

*Ice

*Regular unleaded gasoline

CABIN ACCOMMODATION PACKAGE

Arrival: 3pm Departure: 12pm

Rates

230-275\$ /cabin/day - Maximum 4 people - MINIMUM 2 nights Community room and other rentals not included

Package

- Boat provided (motor not included) and possibility to bring your own boat
- Ecotourism type package, including mainly outdoor activities
- No fishing allowed
- *Discount on stays of 7 nights and more at all times

Products and services

- ➤ Rustic cabin equipped with: 4 single beds, pillows, toilet, 1 rectangular table with 4 chairs, stove with propane oven, dishes (8 place settings), dish soap, pots and pans, coffee maker, kettle, toaster, utensils, BBQ, wood stove (firewood included), propane furnace, 12V outlet in the kitchen, broom, dustpan and mop. Please note that there is only a mattress cover and a pillow cover. Bring your own bedding (blanket or sheets and pillowcase), towels, dish towels and dish cloths.
- > INTEGRATED EQUIPMENT AND SYSTEMS: The cabin is equipped with a solar energy lighting system

Security

- A detailed map of the lake will be given to you upon your arrival and available in the cabin. Possibility of downloading the map on the AVENZA mobile application (link to come for the Waconichi Lake map).
- > One size fits all life jackets available recommended to bring your own PFD and for children.

Activities:

- ➤ Hiking, paddle boarding, kayaking, canoeing, pedal boating, star gazing, tea and mushroom picking, board games and outdoor games, teepee;
- > The loan of canoes, paddleboards, kayaks and pedal boats is possible on site and included in the package.

What to bring:

Food for the duration of your stay (no food or condiments sold on site)
Personal PFDs for children
Bedding (sheets, blankets or sleeping bag)
Towels, dish towels and dish cloths
Soap and shampoo
Drinking water

INFORMATION

Take into account that there are several users on the site and on the lake. We are not responsible for stolen or broken objects during your stay, remember to lock the door before leaving to avoid any incident.

Registration and key collection

Check-in is done at the reception desk of the Waconichi Lake cabins site. There you can pick up the key to the cabin and obtain the necessary information for your stay.

Electricity

The cabins are powered solely by solar panels that recharge a bank of batteries. Do not leave the lights or other appliances requiring electricity on when not needed.

First Aid

A first aid kit is located in the dining room. If you use it or take something inside please notify a Waconichi staff member so that we can replace the missing items.

When you check out

Please leave the premises as you found them, i.e. clean and in good condition. If you do not, you will be charged a \$100 cleaning fee. If a breakage or a problem occurs, please do not hesitate to contact the Waconichi site manager.

Electricity

Make sure all lights and appliances are turned off.

Windows

Make sure to close all windows when you leave.

Dishes

Make sure that the dishes used are clean and put away as they were when you arrived

Keys

Please leave your keys at the Waconichi Lake site reception and make sure any purchased items or rental as been payed before leaving. The cabin must be vacated by 12:00 noon.

Prohibitions

SMOKING IS PROHIBITED INSIDE THE ACCOMMODATION UNITS - Additional cleaning fees may apply if the smell of smoke persists.

No animals are allowed in the cabins and all other premises.

"Outdoor activities can involve certain risks. You must therefore always ensure that you have the skills and abilities required for your chosen activity. It is very important to be aware of the risks inherent to this activity, to know and respect your abilities and to have the appropriate equipment, when required."

Federal regulations prohibit anyone from operating a boat equipped with a motor unless they have proof of having successfully completed a boating safety course in Canada prior to April 1, 1999 or a Pleasure Craft Operator Card issued following the successful completion of a Transport Canada approved test.

As stipulated in the Wildlife Area Regulations, any person who engages in the activity of fishing must, upon exiting the wildlife reserve, report this activity to the place determined for this purpose, indicating his daily catch. Any failure to comply with this regulation constitutes an offence and is subject to a minimum fine of \$250.

In the event of damage to equipment, material or theft, compensation will be claimed.




